


Sacrament of Marriage: Call the office 9 to 12 months prior to the proposed wedding date.





A few updates on things happening in the parish:

- †Father Paul Oye, OP, has been assigned here permanently as one of our hospital chaplains. Maybe you did not know this but Father Paul was originally supposed to be an interim chaplain until another Dominican was able to come from Nigeria. We are glad to have the stability of both Fathers Paul and Modestus as our hospital chaplains and as part of our parish family.
- Bishop Gainer has asked all parishes to pray the Saint Michael Prayer either before, during, or after Masses starting on the First Sunday of Lent. Since we will already pray this prayer during Lent, there will not be much of a change, but after Lent I would like to keep the other prayers we have been praying before Mass, and so the Saint Michael Prayer will be prayed after the Prayer, after Communion before the Final Blessing.
- Phas a follow-up to our Listening Sessions on Clergy Sexual Abuse here in the parish from last Fall and following up on Bishop's Gainer's own Listening Sessions, next week I will publish some events we are planning here in the parish to continue to address this important issue.
- †I know this may seem very early to discuss this but starting on Memorial Day Weekend, we will be making some changes in our Mass Schedule. From Memorial Day Weekend to Labor Day Weekend, we will have a SUMMER SCHEDULE. On Sunday morning, Masses will be celebrated at 7:30 am, 9:30 am, and 11:30 am. Make a note of that. Also, starting Memorial Day Weekend and continuing after Labor Day, our Saturday night and Sunday night Masses will change from 5:15 pm and 5:30 pm to 5:00 pm. We will be publishing these new times many times before it all begins but I just wanted to give you a heads-up early so you can adjust to it.
- †You will be receiving a letter from me concerning the Diocesan Annual Campaign in the near future. I will give you our goal in the next week or so. I know that we will be successful. Obviously, lots more to come about this!
