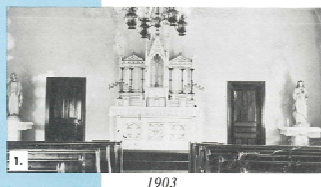
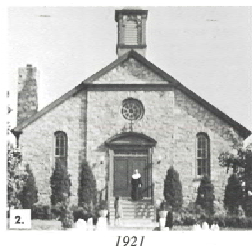
THE EVOLUTION OF OUR PARISH

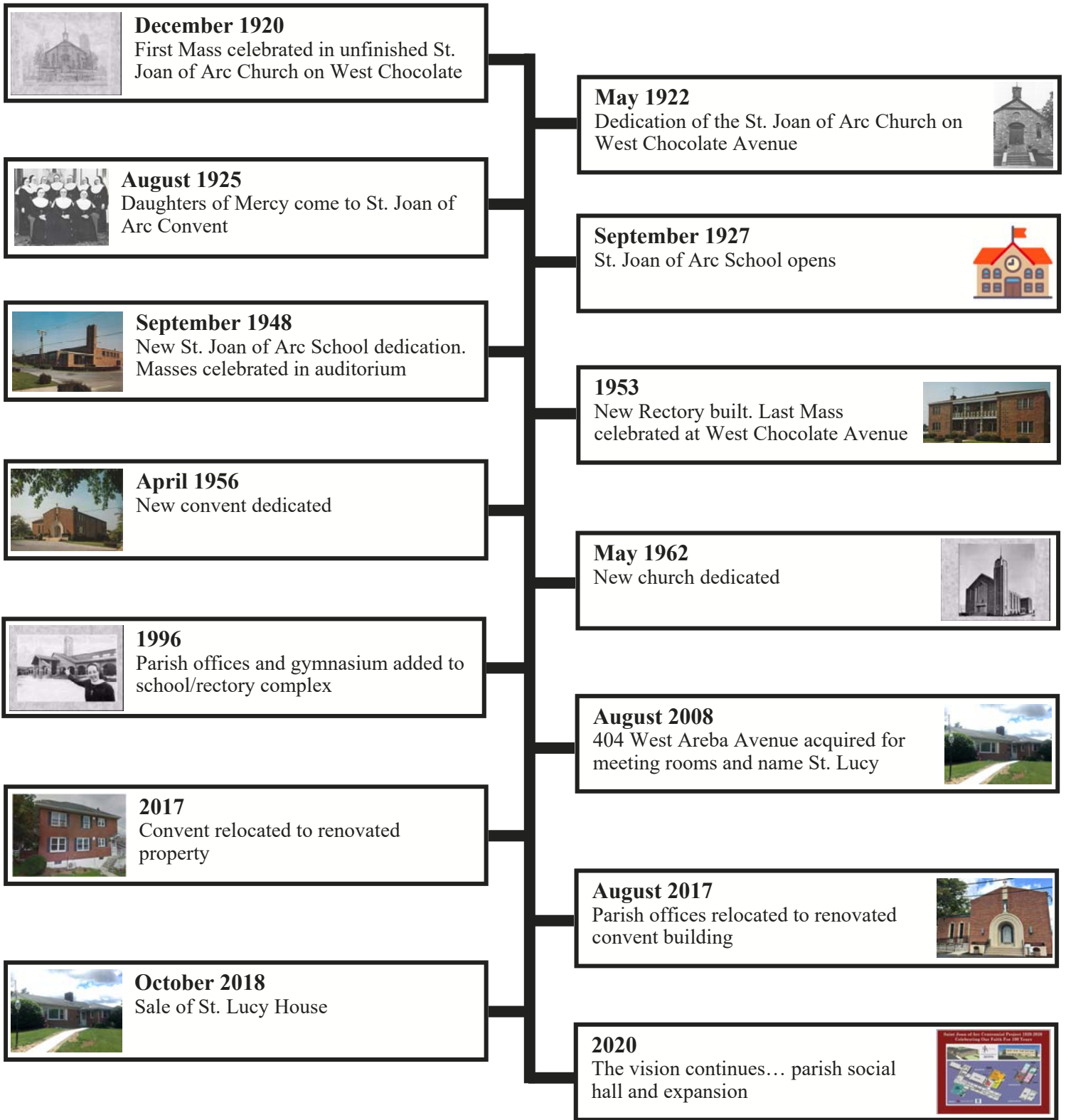
