

An hour of prayer will be dedicated to the sanctity of human life, with exposition of the Holy Eucharist. Please join us.




# PARISH MANAGER POSITION AVAILABLE

# JANUARY: NATIONAL BATH SAFETYMONTH

Children and seniors are those populations who are more at risk of accidents surrounding bath tubs. Bathroom falls are easily

prevented if you take the right precautions

#### Tips to promote safety for both groups are:

- Install non-slip strips or mats in the bottom of your bathtub
- Have safety handles for climbing in and out of the tub or shower, and by the toilet keep a non-slip rug or mat on the floor at the entry/exit of the shower
- Make sure the bathroom floor stays clean and dry
- Keep a portable phone in your bathroom in case of emergencies
- Test the water. Make sure it is not too hot for either adults or children

For children: American Academy of Pediatrics recommends always having an adult present for children under age 4. Make sure sharp edges around the spigot are rubber-covered and ensure children's' toys do not have sharp edges.
