I still marvel at it but I have heard through many people that this was a longstanding tradition, especially in ethnic parishes from Eastern Europe. The wise men came to the house where Jesus was with Mary, his Mother and they offered gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. We do the reverse: we pray that the Lord Jesus will come to OUR houses and bring to us His peace and mercy and love. The grace of a peaceful, loving, forgiving home is one of the greatest gifts we will ever experience in this life.

The role of the Council is to:

- unify clergy and laity in leadership and service

Who can become a Parish Pastoral Council member?

To become a member of the Parish Pastoral Council, a nominee must:

- Be a registered active member of St. Joan of Arc Parish and at least 18 years old
- Be willing to give time and talent to the parish community
- Be willing to attend Council meetings, serve on committees, support and attend parish activities, and be open to God's will regarding parish needs
- Be willing to share his or her unique gift of life experience

How do I volunteer or nominate someone?

- All nominees will receive confirmation of their nomination.
- Please note: St. Joan of Arc clergy, parish and school employees are not eligible to serve on the Council.
