## God's Way - "The Road to Kindness"



We want to share two stories of Kindness impacting our college students. Both of these Kindness stories were shared with us by the parents/grandparents of the student.

Our first story involves a student that is in an accelerated nursing program at a school in Pittsburgh. This program is very intense and the expectations on the part of the school are that only 50% of the students that get accepted in the nursing program will complete it. It is a very competitive program and some students are also very competitive in how they approach their classes and working with their classmates. Our student is in her final year and it has been a journey of overcoming challenges - some health issues and a close friend recently passing away. It is so nice to hear how a few of her classmates have helped her with sharing class notes, setting up study groups so that she can quickly absorb the important material, and offering to take her scheduled shift at the hospital. Our student has been so touched and is so grateful for the Kindness of her classmates during these challenging times. It is so nice to hear that Kindness can overcome the competitive drive in our college programs.

Our second story involves a student that is completing her master's program in accounting at a school in Florida. This master's program is often needed for students that have majored in accounting so they can have sufficient college credits to be able to take the Certified Public Accounting exam. This student was having some difficulty with an advanced tax class and the final exam was on a Monday morning at 8:30am. She studied the entire weekend for the final exam and could not understand one of the complex areas. She reached out to a few classmates that she was friends with and each one said they were busy. One of her classmates that is an acquaintance (that loves taxes), lives off-campus and said that she could drive in and meet the student at 7:00 pm on Sunday night. On her way into campus, this classmate got into a small accident and did not get to campus until 10:30 pm. It could have been easy for this classmate to go back home after this accident, however, this classmate worked with the student until 2 am and helped her to understand this complex area. The student took the test and received an "A"! Once again, the Kindness and care demonstrated by this classmate, even after having an accident, is truly touching!

It is so nice to hear both of these stories and we can clearly see God's Way -"The Road to Kindness at work!
