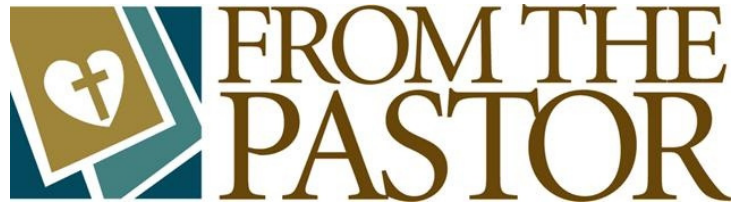

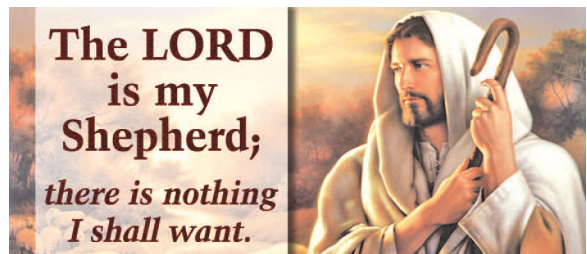
The former parish office space (we still need a name for it!) has been painted and new carpet installed. We will begin to use this space by mid-November for parish ministries and organizations. The rooms will be:



The parish recently acquired a subscription to a Catholic Media service called “FORMED”.

This resource will make available to all members of the parish a vast amount of Video and printed materials that can be viewed at home or here in the parish. Please plan and stop by the 2nd Sunday Social in November to check out this new service.

God’s Way – “The Road to Kindness” 

The theme for this week is: How do we cultivate Kindness in our children? If you were asked this question, what would be your answer? Please reflect on this question!

Recent surveys done by Harvard University and statements in a recent book entitled “Why Empathetic Kids Succeed in Our All-About-Me-World,” indicate that “Teens today are 40% less empathetic and kind than they were 30 years ago!” It went on to indicate “that the emphasis by parents today is on performance.” “Parent discussions become predictable and focus on, what did you learn at school today or what was your grade on that test.”

The study and the book go on to highlight four ways for us to Cultivate Kindness in our children – excerpts include:

1. **Be a Model for Kindness:**
Children are always watching our behaviors.
2. **Expect Kindness in Others:**
Express your views about unkind behavior and that it is unacceptable.
3. **Value of Kindness:**
Stress kindness more than performance.
4. **Reflect on Kindness:**
Have regular “Kindness Discussions” with your children. The Harvard study indicates that we should ask more questions that elicit our children’s thoughts, feelings and experiences.

By watching you be Kind and talking about Kindness-Kindness can become contagious! So, when was the last time you had a “Kindness Discussion” with your children? Please start this week!
