



DO YOU HAVE HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE?

A study from the National Institutes of Health, combined with expert opinions from the Ameri-

can Heart Association and American College of Cardiology, has resulted in updated guidelines that define high blood pressure. The new guidelines would mean more than 8 million people will now be considered to have high blood pressure. The recommendations are to collaborate with your clinician about your blood pressure and, if needed, the best way to treat it. In addition to medication, exercise, maintenance of a healthy weight, reducing stress and eating a "heart healthy" diet are recommended ways to either treat high blood pressure or even prevent it.

St. Joan of Arc Nurse Ministry offers blood pressure checks monthly during the first weekend of the month after all masses, except for noon and Sunday 5:30 pm. All are welcome.
