
ADULT FAITH

There is still time to take advantage of the tax breaks for charitable giving for 2020. Just to highlight a few:

- All charitable cash contributions to qualifying organizations are deductible up to 100% of your adjusted gross income (AGI).
- Up to \$300 of charitable donations can be deducted from your AGI even if you don't itemize.
- A corporation can claim a charitable income tax deduction up to 25% of the corporation's taxable income.
- Charitable Gifts of Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) for qualifying retirement plans for those 72 years of age and up are 100% deductible.
- Please consult with your financial advisor to review the options that benefit your particular tax plan.


Other creative methods of tax deductible giving include:

- Gifts of Stock which have reached new highs on the indices.
- Gifts of Real Estate which are deductible at appraised value.
- Online giving with automatic payments.

Would you like Your PA state tax dollars to go directly to St. Joan of Arc School?

Did you know that if you pay more than \$3500 (Line 12 of your PA income Tax Return) in PA taxes you may be eligible to receive a 90% tax credit for a contribution to the Pennsylvania State EITC scholarship fund program that helps students afford tuition at a St. Joan of Arc. Families who join the Central Pennsylvania Scholarship Fund will receive a tax credit for 90% of the amount pledged, all of which will be given to the school in the form of a donation. (For example if you owe \$3500 in PA taxes, and you make a contribution with the attached agreement to St. Joan of Arc for \$3500, 90% or \$3150 will go to St. Joan of Arc, while your PA tax liability is reduced to \$350)

Your contributions could provide assistance to our school in the following ways:

- Enable the school to offer increased financial aid to more families.
- As participation in the program is for 2 years at a time it will allow us better planning.
- By increasing our funding for financial aid this may help us to keep our tuition costs as low as possible for all students and their families.
- Once a contributor joins the program they are able to continue renewing every two years indefinitely so the
 donation could potentially become a long-term blessing to our school and its students.
