
We meet next on **January 13** as we continue our study of the Catholic Letters with 1st Peter.

Christmas will be upon us in a few short days. Tomorrow, December 21st, marks the winter solstice, the longest night of the year. Sunset will occur at 4:44 PM. Barring cloud cover, the heavens will be lit with what appears to be a star on the southwest horizon. To the delight of many, the popular press is calling it the "Christmas Star." It is actually a natural phenomenon- the convergence of the orbital paths of the planets Jupiter and Saturn as viewed from the Earth's vantage point. Let us take comfort in the love of our families, whether they can be present with us, or send their love from a distance.


Let us be joyful and celebrate.
