This past week we received all the approvals - from the College of Consultors, the Diocesan Building Committee and Derry Township - to begin renovations on the former convent. The renovations will include: a handicapped accessible ramp; ADA compliant men and women's restrooms; air-conditioning (I purposely did not say "new" because the convent never had AC); upgraded electrical service; internet and WIFI capability; changing all of the former bedrooms into office space; making meeting spaces on the first floor; a complete cosmetic update with new flooring, paint and ceiling tiles; and, finally, the complete renovation of the chapel to be used by the parish for adoration, daily visits, prayer groups, class masses, and the occasional baptism or small wedding.

It is amazing how much is being done. The total cost will be \$554,000. We will borrow half of this from the diocese to be amortized over 5 years. Our debt service will be roughly \$60,000 a year. Our HEART OF THE PARISH Fund will be used toward paying off the loan. As you know, HEART OF THE PARISH is a restricted fund that can only be used for capital improvements. We have been averaging (conservatively) \$100,000 per year in this fund (thank you, thank you, thank you to those using that envelope) and we will obviously have the money to service the debt. I have a feeling we will pay that off before the end of the five years!

It is estimated that the renovation will take roughly four months so if we start by the beginning of March we should be done by the end of June and still have July and August to move in before the school year starts. Of course, God willing and with the help of your prayers. It will be so good to have more space for staff members and for the parish. Did you know that three of our staff have no real office and that Meeting Room C is used by seven groups each week? I forget who said it but it is true: "a place for everything and everything in its place". With the convent renovation, that will start to be true here at Saint Joan of Arc! God bless!
