
PARISH MISSION STATEMENT





THE CENTENNIAL PROJECT



Happy Father's Day to all of our earthly fathers, both spiritual and temporal. Whether you're a grandfather or great grandfather, godfather, priest or religious father, expectant father, father-in-law, or just plain dad, this is your day to celebrate and maybe get a little bit pampered-but don't get used to it. Today, families gather together and celebrate their dads. The rest of the year, fathers should make it a priority to regularly block out time for a one to one connection with each of your loved ones, just you and them. The best gift you can give them is your time. No matter how old your children, a "date" with dad is treasured because of the undivided attention they receive. Your role in the family is so vital. You may only be able to do it over the phone but make sure you do it. Your active involvement in the lives of your loved ones is essential for a civil society.

Let us also remember in prayer all the dads who have recently suffered the loss of child. The children of Udvalde weigh heavily on our minds. Troubled youth need their fathers more than ever, and it underscores the vocation of fatherhood as the most important job we have. It's not a great stretch to reason that the incidence of mass casualty events is directly related to the absence of a father's love in the shooter's life, and unfortunately there are way too many examples of just that. Our children need their father's firm guidance. So, let us pray for that strength of purpose to our Father in Heaven, who is always there for us if we just ask for His help.

Catholic schools play an important part in supporting the role of parents in the education and development of children with a moral compass. You are welcome to

visit and to experience first-hand the love and dedication of our faculty and staff.
