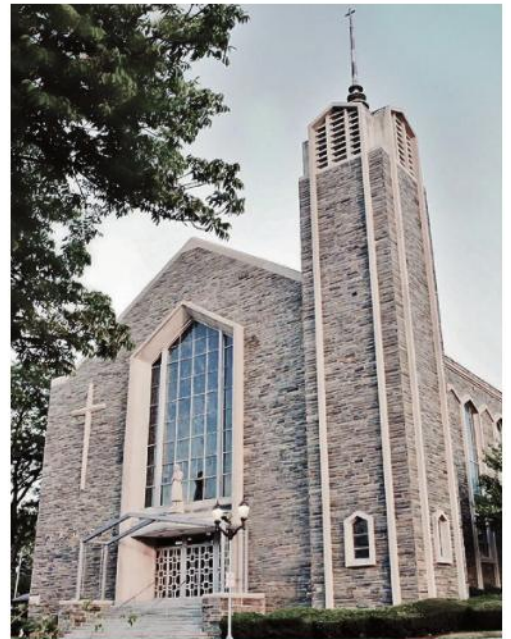

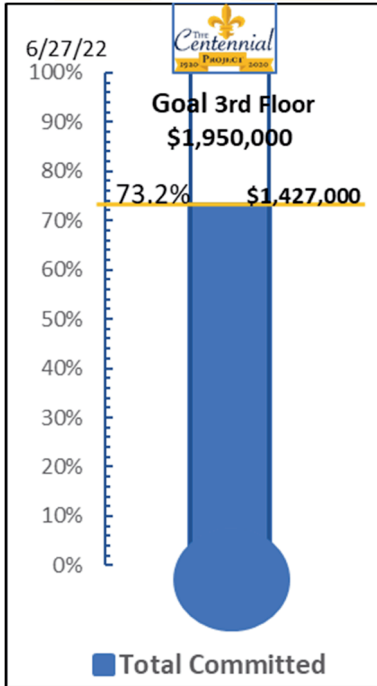

Environmental Recovery Ventilator Unit



Pulling Electrical Cables



Installing Hot & Cold Water Lines

The work continues for the second full week with concentration on utility infrastructure:

- The ERV unit installation in the top left photo is at the heart of the efficiency of the geothermal heating and cooling exchange system.
- The electrical feeds to the scheduled rooms are approaching 50% completion.
- Water supply lines to the student’s restrooms are nearly finished with the faculty rest area next in the queue. We also learned today that our HVAC heat pumps and doors/ door frames on back order have arrived. Praise the Lord for the positive outcome meeting these time-critical deliveries.

Tomorrow is a very important holiday. The United States is blessed to celebrate 246 years of unparalleled liberty on Monday, July 4th. We believe that all men are endowed by Our Creator with inalienable rights and we petition Mary, our country’s patroness, for the continued safety and well-being of our country. Let us pray fervently for “one nation under God” and heed the words of Benjamin Franklin as the Constitution was adopted in 1787-“we have a republic, if we can keep it.” He understood that the success or failure of this new representative democracy hinged upon the integrity of its leaders, and the willingness to compromise and settle disputes without incessant reliance on the courts. The fragile nature was also evident to Ronald Reagan, who warned us that, “Freedom is only one generation away from extinction.” One vote one time for a charismatic autocrat has often been the last autonomous vote cast in some fledgling democracies whose constituents felt isolated and neglected in the existing power structure.

The United States is not immune to the polarization that tears nations apart. Independence Day 1863 was the reckoning of the immense toll of three days of the bloodiest battle of the Civil War, fought just an hour from here. You might have thought we had learned our lesson, but the tension and division in our country today on disparate issues is as strident as it ever has been. This July 4th, please pray for a path to unity and a lowering of the temperature of the fiery rhetoric. Our country needs the guidance of the Spirit, the same wisdom that inspired our founding fathers along the perilous road to self-determination. Without unity, faith and commitment, it’s nearly impossible to form a more perfect union.

Looking at our Centennial Project thermometer, funding is needed to complete the renovation of our school next summer. The DAC Campaign runs from Feb 1, 2022 to January 31, 2023. It is a yearly assessment to support the charitable missions, religious education, spiritual development and the organizational infrastructure of the Diocese of Harrisburg. Our obligation remains the same this year at \$281,000. To date, because of your generosity, our parish has raised \$180,000 towards that goal. At this point in time, receipts are slightly ahead of last year (\$149K vs. \$140K). An important difference in last year's campaign, however, was that St. Joan received a generous bequest of \$90,000 in August, which was a booster shot to meet our commitment. The yearly assessment is mandatory, so it would have come from St. Joan's operational budget had not that wonderful gift been bestowed. This year, there is still \$100,000 yet to be raised. DAC mailers with personal prayer intention requests for the Bishop will be made available in the pews on Sunday July 10. Your gift/ pledge funds dozens of vital social programs in the capital region. With your generosity, those programs will continue to meet the financial, spiritual, and educational needs of our local families.


