

"And I tell you,



As most of you know, the old school on Areba Avenue is being used for our parish functions and events. There we have our new Social Hall, a room for the Knights of Columbus and one for the CCW. We have meeting spaces for all of our groups and ministries. Over the past year or so we have hosted AA Meetings three times a week and use the old library for our Guitars with Vets group. The gymnasium and the back field have been rented to various groups consistently since the school moved up to Sandhill Road. The lockers were relocated to the new school and we are finishing up the repainting of the walls in the hallway where the lockers were. Last year, the rooms were repainted as well. It really is beginning to look more like a parish meeting center than a school. Some of you may have noticed that I have hung a few religious paintings and prints in the hallway as well as begun putting statues in the building as well. Most of these are from around the parish that were not being used; but we could use more. If any of you have any religious pictures that you are not using (or perhaps came from family members who have died), we would be glad to have them. They need to be larger—at least 12X14 (including the frame)—in order to be used. I encourage every family to have good, Catholic imagery in your homes and to display them proudly but I know that sometimes we receive things that we don't know where to put them. As you go through things in your house, if you find anything that might be donated to the parish, drop them off at the Adult Education Classroom immediately on the right as you enter the old school from the Valley Road entrance by the Parish Center. The doors are open throughout the week. Thank you in advance and know that your Catholic artwork will be put to good use!

#### **Respect Life**

Countering Misinformation About Abortion Second in a Series

Q. If abortion has been banned in a woman's state, will she have access to the necessary treatment for ectopic pregnancy?

A. Yes. An ectopic pregnancy occurs when a fertilized egg implants outside the mother's uterus, usually in a fallopian tube. Ectopic pregnancies are never viable and are always a risk to the mother's life, because the growing fetus can burst the fallopian tube causing severe internal bleeding. The necessary treatment involves medication or surgery to remove the pregnancy and sometimes the fallopian tube. In these instances, separation of the mother and the fetus is medically necessary in order to protect the life of the mother, with the tragic and unintended result of the demise of the fetus. These treatments are not direct killing and are not the same as abortion.

"Chemical abortions, which are being heavily promoted by the abortion industry and its allies, cannot treat an ectopic pregnancy according to the FDA. The treatments for ectopic pregnancy are not the same procedures used by induced abortions, which even Planned Parenthood admits. As a pro-life OB/GYN who's practiced my entire career in hospitals that do not allow abortions, I have never been prevented from safely treating an ectopic pregnancy."

"It is clearly the standard of care for any physician to intervene in a pregnancy that presents a risk to the mother's life. Laws restricting induced abortion will not prohibit such an intervention."




