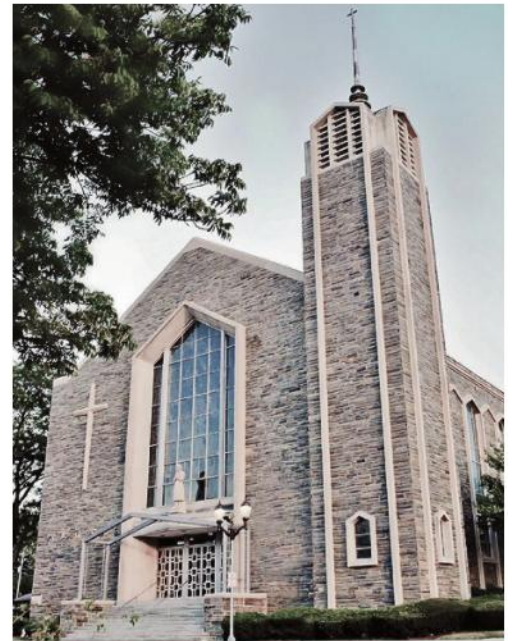

Respect Life

**Countering Misinformation About Abortion
Third in a Series**

Q. If abortion has been banned in a woman’s state, will she still have access to medical treatment in the event of a miscarriage?

A. Yes. “There is no state in which a pro-life law would prohibit or criminalize medical treatment for a miscarriage...

“For the average person, there may be some confusion as to whether a state law criminalizes ‘miscarriage’ because the term is used in some state statutes in conjunction with the term ‘abortion.’ In addition, within the medical community, miscarriages are often referred to as ‘spontaneous abortions.’ There are, however, several reasons that these state laws do not, in fact, criminalize miscarriages or medical treatment for miscarriage.

“First, what is clear from the context of the state laws is that *intent* matters...It is the *intent* to destroy or otherwise jeopardize a preborn child’s life that is prohibited.

“Second, a natural miscarriage occurs without any intent – indeed, often in spite of the intent to keep the baby. There is nothing within any state law that would punish a woman for having or prohibit her from seeking medical attention following a spontaneous miscarriage. Moreover, there is no state law that would punish healthcare providers for or prohibit them from giving medical attention to a woman seeking medical care for a miscarriage...

“Third, pro-abortionists distort medical terms and experiences...the medical treatment a woman receives following a miscarriage is *not* an abortion. At the time a woman undergoes these procedures, the preborn baby has already died...

“Finally, there are claims from pro-abortionists that...the very fact that a woman experiences a spontaneous miscarriage opens her up to potential (wrongful) criminal charges...However, in these very rare and obscure cases that have been cited, the charges occurred because some evidence existed that the woman caused a self-induced abortion, and did not experience a miscarriage. In addition, in all the cases cited, the charges were overturned. Moreover, there is practically no support for criminal charges to be brought against women having abortions, rather, the laws are directed against those providing abortions.”

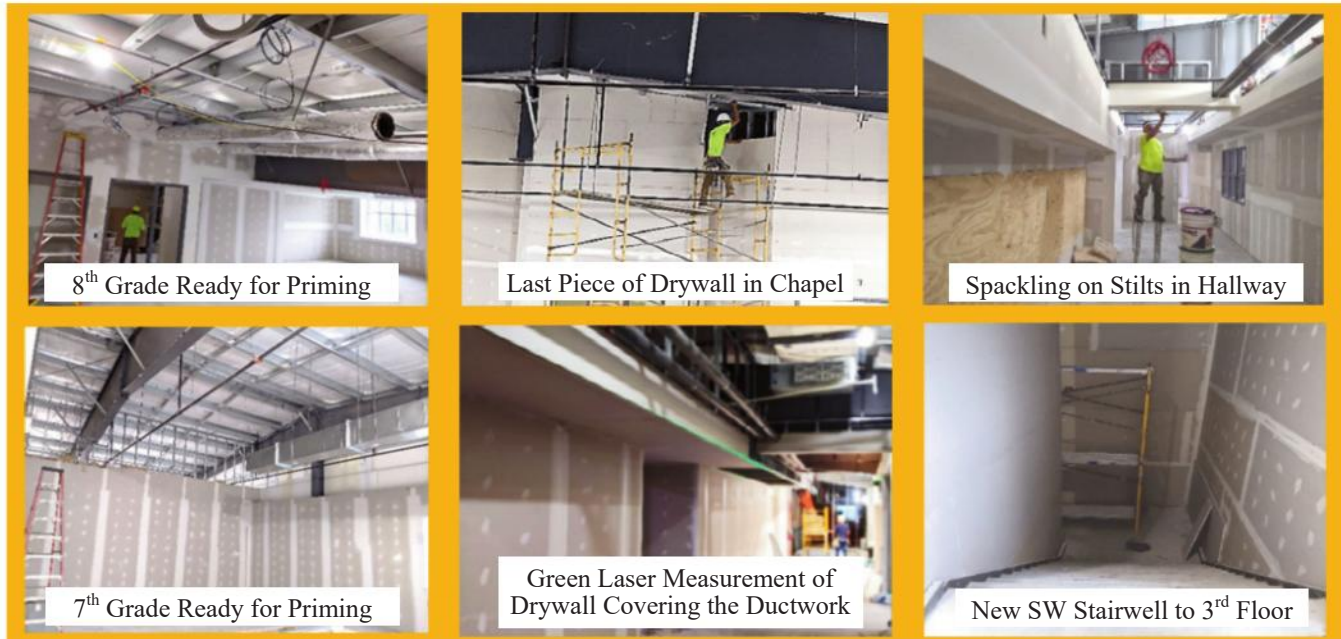

Construction Progress as of 7/25/22



Six weeks out from the first day of school, we are still on target for completion. As of this writing, the code inspection for the drywall is due on the 26th, and assuming compliance, the painters will be here on the 27th to prime the drywall. Once the painting is complete, (hopefully this week), the installation of the ceiling grid, light fixtures, and room supply/return air ducts can begin. Please remember the crews and crew leaders in your prayers to keep the renovations going smoothly. They are anticipating well, and are working very hard to meet the completion date. A special thanks to our facilities director, Matt Dunkle, who is coordinating the entire project.

As far as the Centennial Project, our generous parishioners and benefactors have provided the funds needed for the planned six classroom expansion this year. With rising prices and a desire to complete the remainder of upper floor by September 2023, we continue to need your financial support. To meet the goal (shown on the thermometer) we need to raise \$520,000 in a timely fashion to try to avoid the destructive impact of rampant inflation, which is flirting with 10%.

Our Centennial Kickoff was in late April of 2019, and in spite of a two-year historical pandemic, to date we have received gifts and pledges totaling \$4.2 mm. (You may recall that the cost of the original property before any renovations was \$5 mm.) We just need to stretch a little more to cross the finish line!



To all of those who have contributed, our sincere thanks. Your gifts, along with the many of you who have been so exceedingly generous with multiple gifts, made all of this possible. A special thanks to all of the families who have been earnestly meeting and completing their pledge payments. The time has flown by so quickly. For those of you who may have temporarily paused your installments and are able to restart, it's not too late, and we would be greatly appreciative as it is very much needed.

For those who can, please consider a gift or pledge. You are investing in the church's mission of raising our children and grandchildren in the faith, while providing a superior education. St. Joan of Arc School is Middle States Accredited, S.T.E.M. and Blue Ribbon certified. As a partner with the parents, we develop the minds, hearts and spirit of our children, which is our solemn responsibility as their guardians.
