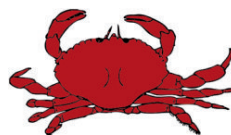

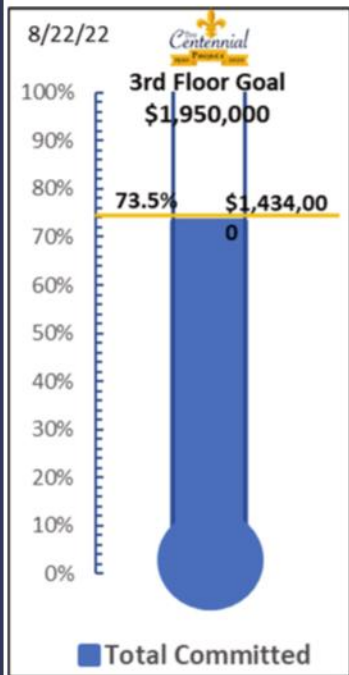

## Construction Progress as of 8/22/22



This week is the last full week of construction. We are planning on having our occupancy code review at the end of the week. There is some LED panel wiring, a little more painting, flooring, coving, & restroom plumbing remaining. A great deal of work has been accomplished in just 12 weeks! Many thanks to our contractors.

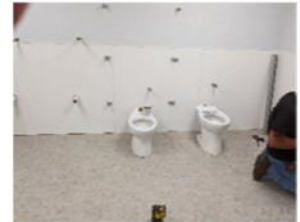

It's amazing that we will have three classes each of Four-Year-Old Preschool classrooms through Second Grade with the goal of adding one new class of Grades 3, 4, & 5 in the next three years. That will increase our student body to nearly 600 by the Fall of 2025. (That's double the capacity of the Areba Avenue School!) Classrooms, laboratories, study lounge, and the chapel are all being planned with the expected growth in mind.


