As I will always remember a conversation I had with a man from my former parish in Elysburg. He came to me because his beloved mother was in a steady physical and mental decline as she grew older. This once vibrant woman, a true matriarch to her family, was unable to walk any longer, had dementia, and had many of the limitations that go along with aging. He hated to see her become so dependent on family and caregivers. He hemmed and hawed but finally came out and asked me: "My mom has no dignity left. Why is euthanasia so wrong? I can't stand to see her in this state!" The question came from a place of frustration and desperation but it was, and is, always the wrong question to ask. I gently told this man that his mom still had great dignity. I reminded him that there was a point when his mom was a baby and was totally dependent on others. Did that take away her human dignity? I reminded him that only God has power over life and death and while we have a real obligation to keep his mom and others like her as comfortable as we can, we can't step in and take the life of another person. There is a time for everyone to go and that time is determined by the Lord, not us. I acknowledged his frustration and how he hated to see his mom so helpless but encouraged him to help his mom in the final weeks or months of her life. To care for her as she once cared for him. It is a great grace and blessing to care for the sick and the dying as they leave this world and go into the hands of God. Euthanasia is playing God. We can never consider it a "mercy". The real mercy is tenderly caring for our loved ones until the moment God calls them home!

You can give voice to truth, you can make a difference!



- For those who have reached the age of 72, a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from a tax-deferred retirement account (such as a traditional, or rollover IRA, 401k, etc.) can be used to meet required minimum distributions and would not be considered income for tax purposes.
- A Donor Advised Fund (DAF) allows for a long-term appreciated stock to be donated and receive a current year tax deduction. The assets can then be granted over time while investing the remaining balance of the assets to grow future grants.
- Gifts of Real Estate are deductible at appraised value.
- Ask about our naming program for lead gifts. You can create a lasting tribute to a special person in your life—a dedication or a memorial.




