
Knights of Columbus

It was just three short years ago in Advent that we embarked on an exciting new journey to chart the path and trajectory of St. Joan of Arc School. It was the summer of 2019 when our plans to expand our 44,000 sq. ft. Areba Ave. education center took a sharp turn and we entered into a sales agreement to begin evaluating the recently available Lancaster Mennonite Hershey campus. Choosing a twelve-year-old 110,000 sq. ft. building on 35+ acres vs expanding a 72-year-old 44,000 sq. ft. outdated building was an offer we couldn't refuse. On December 19th, the acquisition was settled. Little did we know what lay ahead.

March 17, 2020-We should have been toasting St. Patrick; instead we locked the doors for fear of Covid-19. If ever there was an inopportune time to take on a major real estate purchase, this was pretty close. Thankfully, we had raised enough revenue since April to fund the down payment on the purchase and pay for the first phase of renovations. Construction had just begun and it was just as quickly halted by government order. Thankfully, the school technology infrastructure supported the remote learning in place needed to finish the school year. With God's grace, generous benefactors, and government grants, bills were paid, money raised, construction resumed in early May, and the new school opened on time in August 2020.

God's providence looking kindly upon our parish, our school, and our 3rd Floor renovations is good reason to give thanks for our blessings and rejoice on this third Sunday in Advent (Gaudete). Our third class will be graduating this year. Attendance has skyrocketed from 355 in the last year at the Areba school to 505 this year.

Also, we have been granted Diocesan approval to extend the Centennial campaign until late spring because of the negative impact of Covid-19 pandemic. We humbly ask for your generous support. We hope to raise \$379,000 by then to avoid increasing our mortgage debt. With the end of tax year here, now is the perfect time for maximizing the benefits of charitable giving in the IRS Code. Ask about our legacy naming opportunity program. Thank you, and God bless you!






