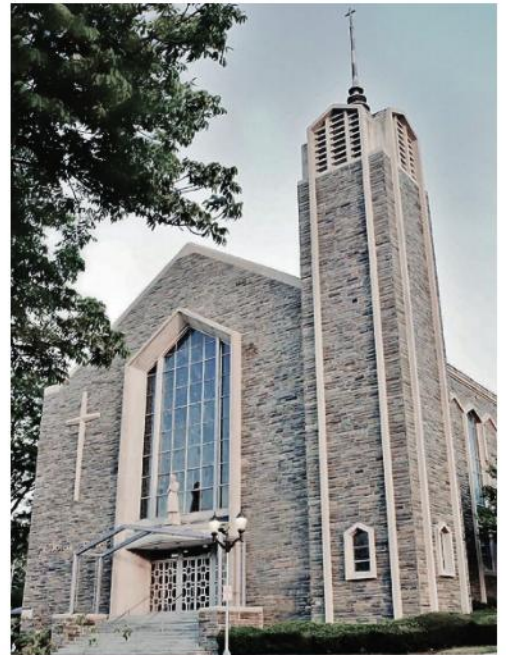

### Road to Kindness

Every morning when we wake up, we have choices to make. We could choose to have a good day or a bad day. We could choose to be kind and caring, or we could choose the opposite. There are times when we are challenged due to current situations, family matters, work issues, etc. These are the times when we need to reach deep inside and think about the times in our life that brought us happiness or when someone was kind to us.

When times come that are challenging and someone is there with a helping hand, well, we view it as there are no coincidences. That person was meant to be there right at that time.

Let's look at why we chose our mantra, Follow God's Way – "The Road to Kindness!"-God is Kind and he wants us to show our Kindness. The Bible often talks about being kind. "Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you." (Ephesians 4:32) and "Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, "(Colossians 3:12).

**Being Kind and caring is your choice.** Mother Teresa often said, "Let no one ever come to you without leaving better and happier. Be the living expression of God's kindness: kindness in your face, kindness in your eyes, kindness in your smile." ### Building a Culture of Life

#### Top Reasons to Oppose Assisted Suicide

Some polls indicate that the public is receptive to assisted suicide. But the same polls show that people's views shift when they learn about its dangers-especially the dangers for those who are poor, elderly, disabled, or without access to good medical care. Consider that, in Oregon and California, some patients' health insurance offered to pay for assisted suicide, but not treatment. And in states where assisted suicide is legal, often no psychiatric evaluation or treatment is required. Additionally, assisted suicide fosters discrimination by creating two classes of people: those whose suicides we spend millions of dollars to prevent and those whose suicides we assist and treat as a positive good.

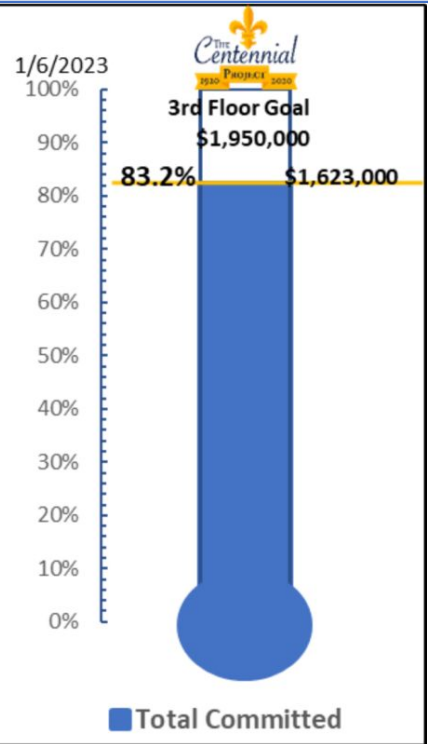
**CENTENNIAL PROJECT STATUS THROUGH 1/6/2023**

**CAMPAIGN PRAYER**

Our most gracious heavenly Father, as You bless us continually with the knowledge of Your abundant gifts, grant us especially the gift of a grateful heart. Help us to respond sacrificially to the challenge before us so that our Church family may move forward in its ministry of worship, education, and service. Give us the faith, courage, and the desire to support this Centennial Project in our Church as we grow for tomorrow. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

Blueprints and financial information were submitted to the Diocese on January 4<sup>th</sup> in advance of our presentation to the Diocesan Building Committee (DBC) on January 18<sup>th</sup>. Pending approval, plans will be presented to Bishop Gainer and the College of Consultors on February 1<sup>st</sup>. The remaining space under review includes two classrooms, a science lab/classroom, an open-air meeting /event/ study area, a small kitchenette, and a 7,000 sq. ft. chapel that can accommodate the student body.

It's an exciting time at St. Joan of Arc School. In retrospect, we didn't anticipate the rate of growth, but remain grateful for the response in meeting the challenge. At this juncture, we are expecting enrollment of at least 530 students next year, which is a 49% increase over the last graduating class at the Areba School in June 2020.



Yes, we have been blessed, and yes, there is still one last mountain to climb. To date, we have \$1.623 million in pledges & receipts vs. a \$1.95 million goal. Our outstanding pledge balance is \$334,000, which is crucial to our financial plan. We are counting on that cash flow continuing, and we need another \$327,000 in new commitments to meet the renovation budget.
