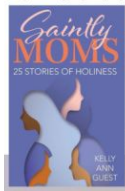

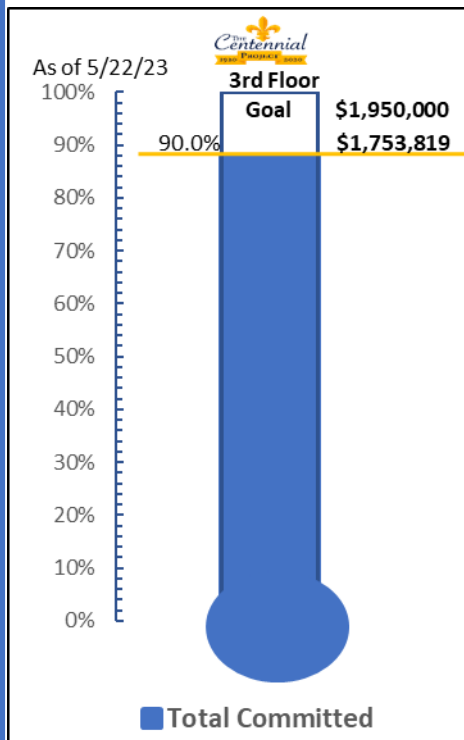

GOOD'S TREE CARE

CENTENNIAL PROJECT-THE NEXT PHASE



The Capital Campaign started over four years ago. Little did we realize in April of 2019 that we were embarking on a wild roller coaster ride. At the time, we were in the second year of planning a 44,000 sq. ft. expansion at the Areba Avenue School. No sooner had the summer arrived, when a wonderful opportunity was dropped in our lap. Providentially, a 100,000 sq. ft., partially finished school on a panoramic 35-acre parcel in Hummelstown became available.

So, we quickly shifted our focus, performed our due diligence, and closed in December on a \$5mm dollar investment. Looming just around the corner was a freight train headed our way... known as the covid-19 pandemic.

Gasp...talk about timing...we had no sooner started the renovations to accommodate the burgeoning enrollment for the August 2020 Grand Opening, then the construction site was abruptly shut down by the Governor. It was a time of scant understanding and little or no direction. It became day to day. People were shut in their homes. Churches were shuttered. Small business evaporated. Revenues and incomes plummeted. It was only the Grace of God, the generosity of our parishioners, the PPP federal bailout, the

birth of Zoom, and the dedication of the faculty and staff, that guided St. Joan of Arc Parish and School through the tempest.

Construction resumed in June and the 1st renovation was completed on time. This was a moment to shine as the school was the model for covid-protocols and the importance of in-person education. We rested in 2021 while planning the six classrooms needed for the 500+ students in the Fall of 2022. Amazingly, the renovation was completed in 9^{1/2} weeks.

This brings us to the present day and the completion of the remaining classrooms and meeting space. Looking ahead, we are hopeful to finish the seven-thousand square foot chapel in the summer of 2024.

None of this could have happened without your financial support. Thank you for your generosity. Thank you for honoring the extension of the campaign due to the shutdown. Ordinarily, it is a three-year process, but due to the devastating impact of covid on fundraising, the Bishop granted an extension.

We now move into our pledge fulfillment stage. We will be mailing updates on pledge status in the next couple of weeks. If you have any questions, please contact Jerry at the Parish Office. Here's where we stand:
