I was the dean of the Northumberland Deanery when I was the pastor of Queen of the Most Holy Rosary in Elysburg so this responsibility is not new to me. Besides getting the title "Very Reverend" in front of my name (as soon as I am no longer the dean, I simply go back to "Reverend" so it keeps you humble!), my main responsibilities will be to call deanery meetings of all the priests in our deanery to discuss matters of mutual concern, to visit the other parishes in our deaneries to make sure the parish registers are complete and well-ordered, to communicate information to the parishes that come from the diocese, and to meet regularly with the other deans of the diocese and with Bishop Senior to advise him on matters relating to the Church in Harrisburg. I am grateful for the confidence of my fellow-priests and the bishop in taking on the role of dean. It will entail a little more work on my part, so I ask for your patience (especially on those days that I need to go to other parishes and "check" the books). If anyone is interested, you can find the full responsibilities of a dean by googling "Canon Law, Role of Deans." Thanks for your prayers!



Time passes so quickly. Four months have elapsed since our last bulletin entennial approvals went very smoothly. On Project Tuesday, September 5th, the new wing of the third floor of the school opened

on time and under budget. It included two new classrooms, a middle school science laboratory, two restrooms, a multipurpose room currently being used as a chapel, and a 2,000 sq. ft. open area for study halls and gatherings. Total expenditures were just over \$980K. Thank you to all who made that happen in just twelve short weeks.

Phase III is the final phase of construction and the best was saved for last. We are working on the final design of the 7,000 sq. ft. chapel. Its purpose is to fulfill the mission of our school as it will be a sanctuary for the Presence of Christ and a retreat for reflection and guidance of the Holy Spirit. The chapel is partially complete. The rough-in electric, drywall, windows, and doors are in place. However, there is still considerable work to be done.

After Phase II expenses, there is \$325,000 remaining in our capital savings account. We have another \$288,000 in pledge balances. It will be crucial that the pledge dollars are recovered since the finishing work of the walls, ceiling, flooring, fixtures, décor, and HVAC will require significant resources. To all who contributed and made this possible, we offer our sincerest thanks. To those who have paused their installments because of finances, please prayerfully consider restarting them. Your contributions are greatly needed but, post-pandemic, we do understand that for some, circumstances may no longer permit it. Give what you can. Finally, we owe a debt of gratitude to those who continue to contribute regularly. Gifts are always welcome and will ultimately decide the extent to which architectural detail of the chapel is realistic. Come visit us at an open house and see all that has been accomplished, through the generosity of many, for the future of our children's spiritual and academic formation.
