PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

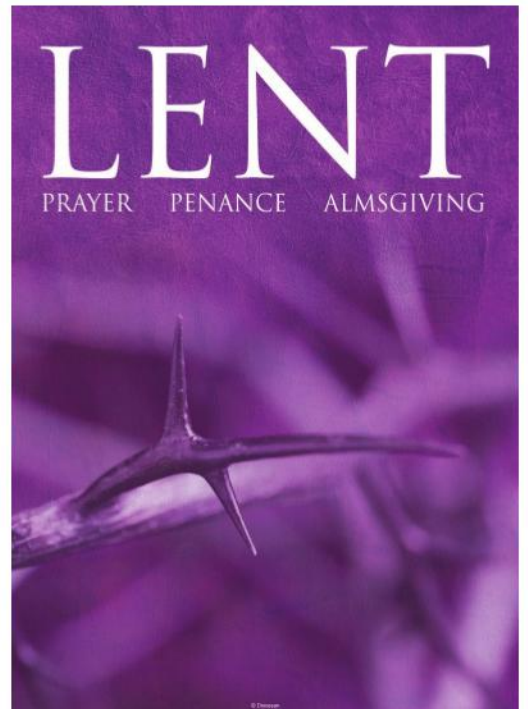

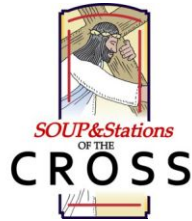
