# FROM THE PASTOR

It seems that God often uses the “least” among us to further his will. Throughout the entire Old Testament, he has a tendency to choose the youngest son for his purposes: Abel over Cain; Isaac over Ishmael; Jacob over Esau (OK, that one was a trick!); David over all of his brothers. In the New Testament, Jesus chooses fishermen and housewives to be his first disciples. And in the history of the Catholic Church, the least likely of people are chosen to receive his messages. Saint Thomas Aquinas, the “Dumb Ox” would revolutionize theology in the Middle Ages. Saint Francis of Assisi was a playboy son of a wealthy cloth merchant who would capture the hearts of the whole world. Saint Therese of Lisieux lived a good part of her life behind cloister walls. When she was dying and it was the tradition to write something about a nun’s life, two of her sisters said, “What can we possibly write about her! There’s nothing to tell!” (Or something like that!) Think of Saint Bernadette at Lourdes or the children at Fatima. Today, on this Divine Mercy Sunday, we recall a young Polish nun, Saint Faustina Kowalska, who received from Christ his message of divine mercy. Why does God do this? The message of the Gospel is so hard for us to understand that he chooses the simple to further his message. The sophisticated of this world will never believe children, the innocent, the simple. WE must become simple, like little children, to believe the great truth of God’s mercy, His love, His care for us. “Unless you become like little children, you will not enter the Kingdom of God!”

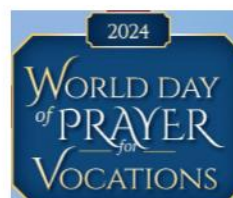
