
Sacrament of Baptism: 1st & 3rd Sunday of each month. Parents are required to attend one class. Call the office to register.

"The Holy Trinity" by Hendrick van Balen, 1620 © Diocesan



Today we celebrate the Solemnity of The Most Holy Trinity. On this day we reflect on the unique teaching of the Christian Church on the nature of God. Saint Athanasius famously (and beautifully) gave us a Creed that delves into the great mystery of the Holy Trinity. The image below was used during the Middle Ages to make clear what the Church teaches about the Holy Trinity. It is still useful today.



The Shield of the Trinity, a visual representation of the doctrine of the Trinity, derived from the Athanasian Creed. The Latin reads: "The Father is God, The Son is God, The Holy Spirit is God; God is the Father, God is the Son, God is the Holy Spirit; The Father is not the Son, The Son is not the Father, The Father is not the Holy Spirit, The Holy Spirit is not the Father, The Son is not the Holy Spirit, The Holy Spirit is not the Son."

VOCATIONS CORNER

On June 2, Deacon Matthew Morelli will be ordained to the priesthood of Jesus Christ at 10 am at Saint Patrick's Cathedral in Harrisburg. This is a special time for our parish community to come together in thanksgiving and celebration for the gift of priesthood to Deacon Matthew Morelli.

Friday June 1:

A Holy Hour will offered with special prayers for Deacon Morelli's ordination from 6 pm - 7 pm in the church. This is an opportunity for you to offer your Holy Hour for a fruitful and holy priesthood for Deacon Morelli. Families are encouraged to attend with their children to foster an appreciation of religious vocations. Children are encouraged to wear their First Holy Communication attire.

Saturday June 2:

Deacon Matthew Morelli will be ordained to the priest-hood of Jesus Christ at 10 am at St. Patrick's Cathedral in Harrisburg. This is a beautiful ceremony which every Catholic should attend or watch online at least once in their life. There will be six sons of the Diocese of Harrisburg ordained, so the cathedral will be crowded. The ordination mass will be live streamed on the Diocese's website.

Sunday June 3:

Father Matthew Morelli will celebrate his first Mass of Thanksgiving at 2 pm. Attending this mass fulfills your Sunday obligation. Families are encouraged to attend with their children to foster an appreciation of religious vocations. Children are encouraged to wear their First Holy Communication attire. Immediately following mass, the CCW will host a reception in the school cafeteria. Father Morelli will greet people and be giving first blessings to individuals and families at the reception. Holy cards remembering Father Morelli's ordination will be available at Mass and the reception for you to continue to pray for him throughout his priesthood.

First Blessing of a Newly Ordained Priest

A special grace may be gained from receiving a "first blessing" of a newly ordained priest. First blessings are customarily given when first Masses are celebrated, but they may be given up to a full year after ordination. Father Matthew Morelli will be giving first blessings at the reception after his first Mass on June 2. After receiving the blessing, the faithful may kiss the palms of the newly ordained priest in recognition of the sacred character of his priesthood and of the hands that now hold the Eucharist and confer the sacraments.
