1st and 3rd Saturday Prayer Ministry

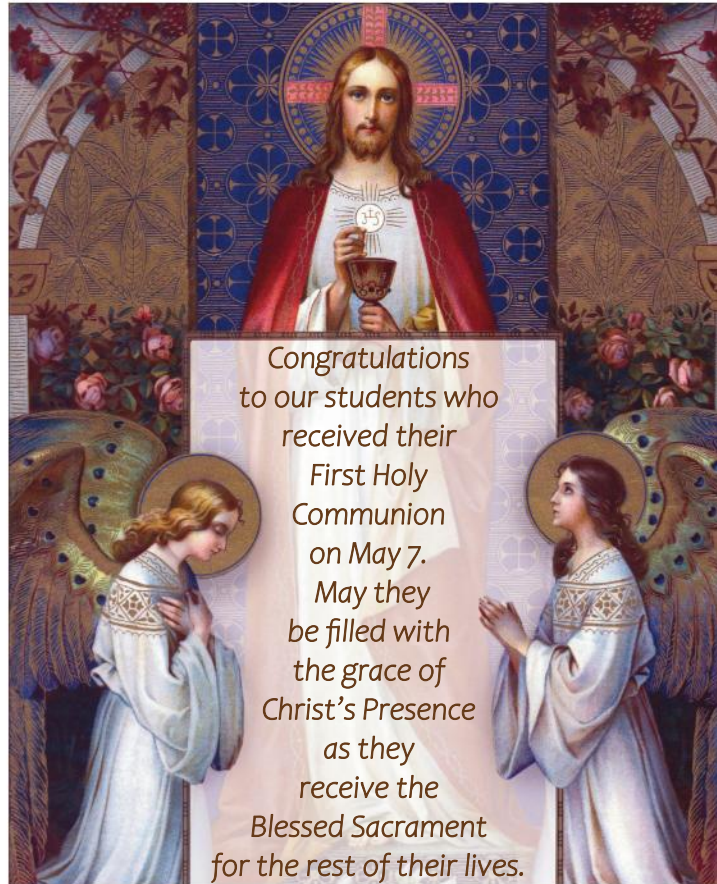

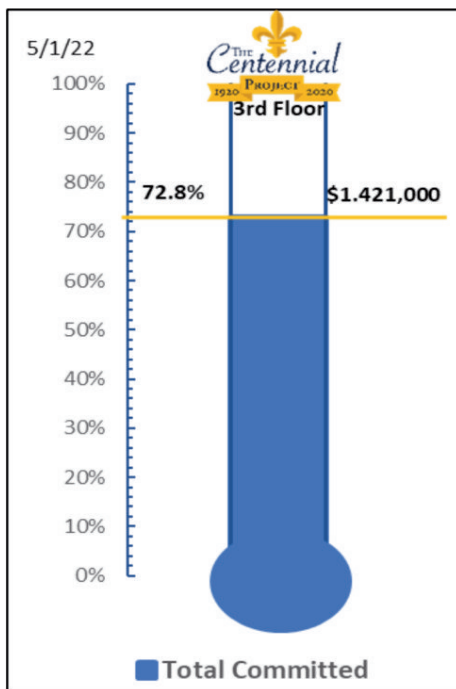


