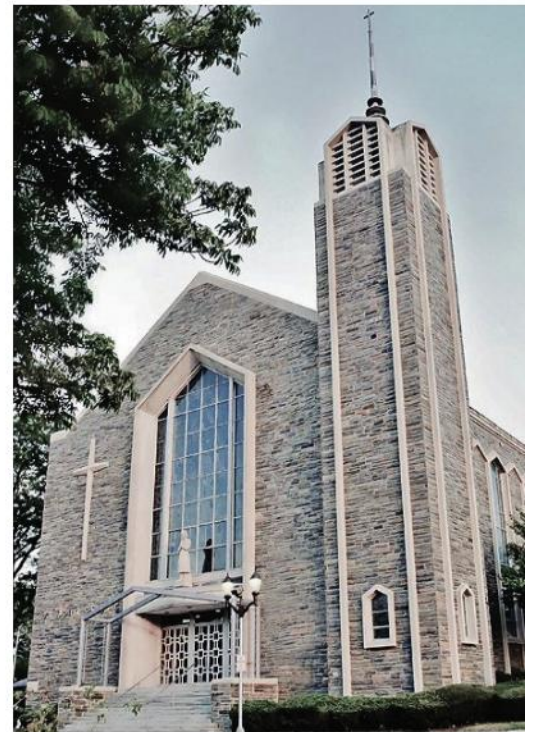

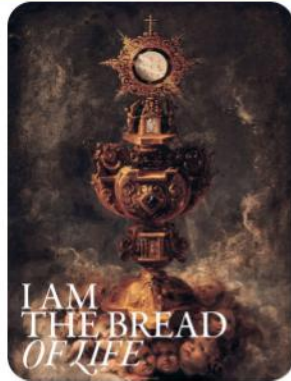

FROM THE PASTOR

For the next four weeks, the Church will give us the Sixth Chapter of Saint John's Gospel at each Sunday Mass. Known as the "Bread of Life Discourse", it begins with the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes and concludes with



many people leaving Jesus because of His teaching on the Eucharist. As the Church in the United States just finished its Eucharistic Revival Congress in Indianapolis, I thought it would be a good idea for Father Key and I to talk at greater length in our homilies about the Holy Eucharist. My series of talks will be specifically about the Mass. I was very, very pleased to learn that in the Parish Survey that we did this past Lent, the vast majority of our parishioners have a great belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, that the Scriptures we hear proclaimed each week are truly the Word of God, and that the Church is part of God's plan for his Family here on earth. More of this during my homilies this coming month but suffice it to say that the facilitator of our survey said he had never seen numbers like this before from other parishes! This is a wonderful thing in today's world where there is great misunderstanding about the Mass, the Eucharist, and Sacred Scripture. I hope you enjoy, but more importantly learn more, about the "source and summit of our Catholic Faith" these next few weeks. I am looking forward to it myself!

Building a Culture of Life

Gender Theory

The Church wishes, first of all, “to reaffirm that every person, regardless of sexual orientation, ought to be respected in his or her dignity and treated with consideration, while ‘every sign of unjust discrimination’ is to be carefully avoided, particularly any form of aggression and violence.” For this reason, it should be denounced as contrary to human dignity the fact that, in some places, not a few people are imprisoned, tortured, and even deprived of the good of life solely because of their sexual orientation. At the same time, the Church highlights the definite critical issues present in gender theory. On this point, Pope Francis has reminded us that “the path to peace calls for respect for human rights, in accordance with the simple yet clear formulation contained in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, whose seventy-fifth anniversary we recently celebrated. These principles are self-evident and commonly accepted. Regrettably, in recent decades, attempts have been made to introduce new rights that are neither fully consistent with those originally defined nor always acceptable. They have led to instances of ideological colonization, in which gender theory plays a central role; the latter is extremely dangerous since it cancels differences in its claim to make everyone equal.”

-Declaration of the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith “Dignitas Infinita” on Human Dignity
